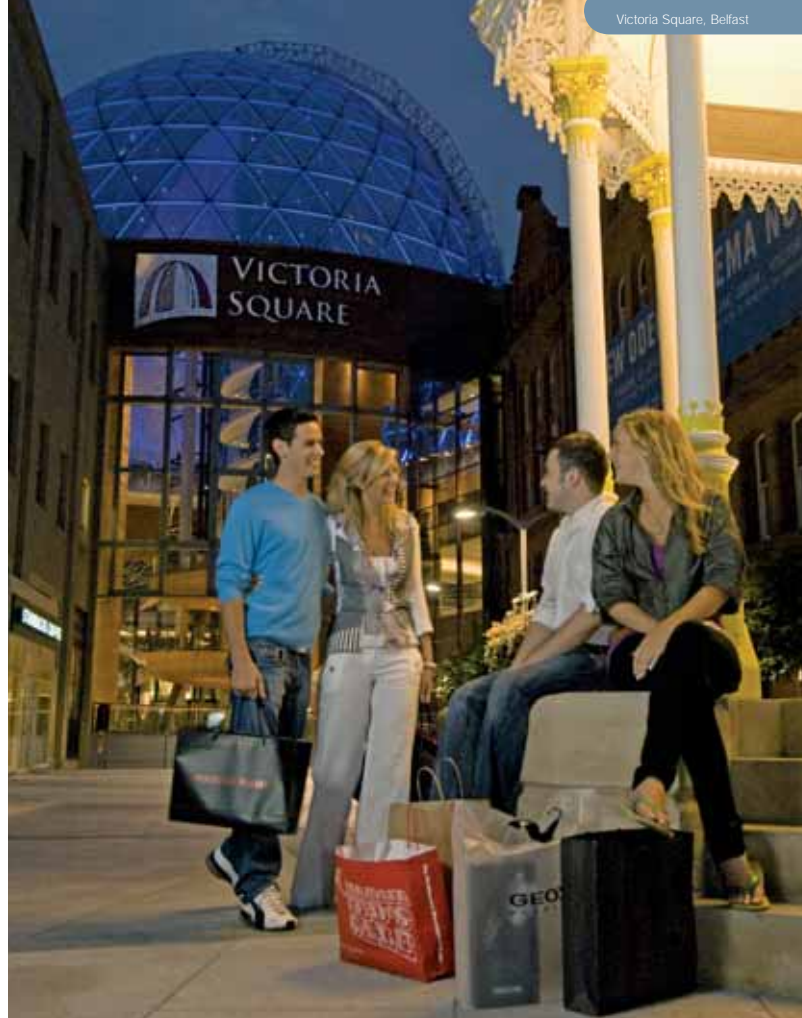
city, Bloomfield Avenue is full of cool boutiques with a mix of cafés and beauty salons to complement the mix for an indulgent day out.

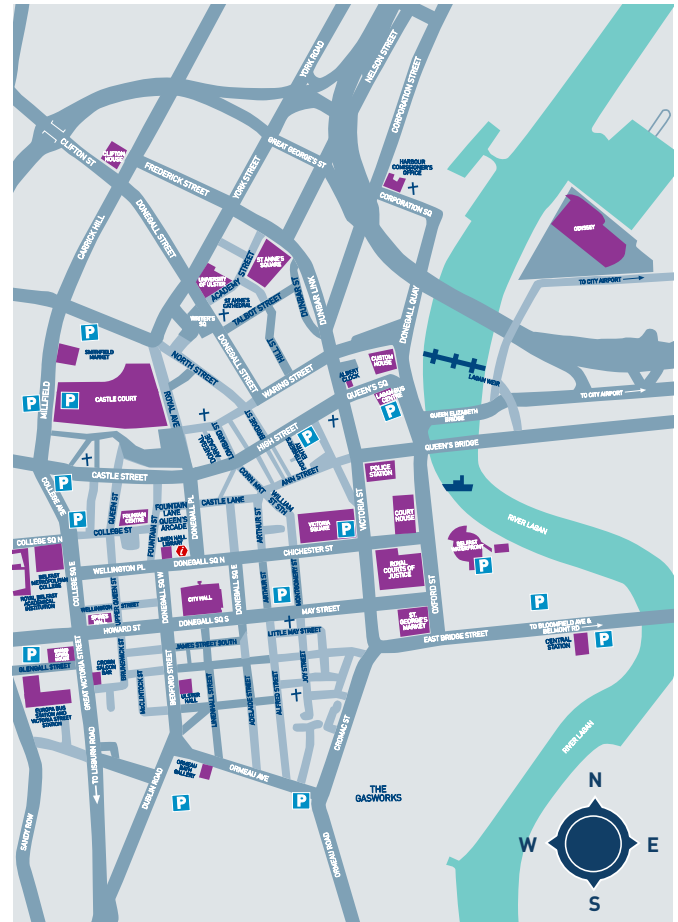
The impressive glass dome of Victoria Square is now a prominent feature of the city's skyline.

# Ormeau Road

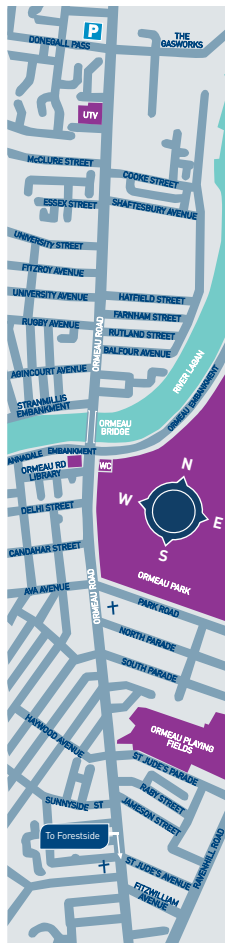
Just a short stroll from the city centre, across the River Lagan, Ormeau Road has become a haven for top independent boutiques.
